## THE VISITORS' BOOK

The award categories are as follows:

Under 9 years, 9 – 11 years, 12 – 14 years, 15 years and over,  
Group Award, Award for machine embroidery.

The theme for this competition is **THE VISITORS' BOOK**

Faces are the inspiration for the book and you will see that from the reference images that the artist has used a number of decorative art sources.

The **original work of the Visitors' Book** is completed in "Or Nué" – a method whereby coloured threads are sewn over gold to give a graduated and luminous effect. The object of the exercise is NOT to reproduce or copy this object but use it for inspiration. You could look at faces, shapes and patterns, metals and colours, size, developing the technique further and all forms of embellishment.

**The Visitors' Book** is open for  
individual entries and group entries

### Guidelines

- ❖ The work must be lightweight, easy to pack, post and store.
- ❖ Any materials and techniques can be used.
- ❖ The work can be 2 dimensional or 3 dimensional.
- ❖ All entries must be presented ready to display:
- ❖ Entries may be mounted on card but no entry should be framed or glazed.
- ❖ Every entry should include an appropriate mechanism to hang the work. If required, flat wooden batons or dowel cut to size should be sent with wall hangings. All the devices for hanging or presenting 3 dimensional pieces must be included with the work.
- ❖ Composite pieces: group work or mobiles or an entry made up of several items should include clear instructions on how to assemble and display the work.
- ❖ 2 dimensional entries should not exceed 150 x 150cms. 3 dimensional pieces should not exceed 50 x 50cms.
- ❖ All the work entered must have been created specifically for the de Denne Competition.
- ❖ **All participants must be Young Embroiderers.**

### 3 EASY STEPS

1. Complete this entry form and send it with your entry to arrive no later than: **Friday 09 September 2011**

#### INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES

2. Write your name and age and the name of your Young Embroiderers group on a label and attach this securely to the work.

Group Leaders sending in a number of individual entries in one parcel should provide a contents list and completed entry for each Young Embroiderer. A label with the Member's name, age, membership number and the name of their group must be attached to each entry.

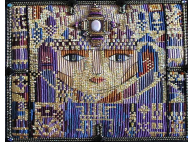
#### GROUP ENTRIES

Group Leaders should provide a list headed with the name of the group, a title for the work and the names and ages and membership number of all the Young Embroiderers involved in creating the entry.

**3. ALL ENTRIES MUST ENCLOSE STAMPS TO THE CORRECT VALUE, AN ADDRESS LABEL AND PACKING MATERIAL FOR THE SAFE RETURN JOURNEY OF THE PARCEL.**
